- 3 Section the hair prior to styling. Style the lower layers first.
- 4 Plug the product into the mains power supply.
- 5 Slide the on/off switch to turn on.
- 6 Working on one section at a time, run the straightener through the entire length of the hair without stopping.
- 7 Only repeat twice per section to prevent damage to the hair.
- 8 After use, turn the appliance off and unplug.
- 9 Let the appliance cool before cleaning and storing away.

CLEANING AND MAINTENANCE

- Unplug the appliance and allow to cool.
- Wipe all the surfaces with a damp cloth.
- Don't use harsh or abrasive cleaning agents or solvents.
